Message from the Leadership Team

"Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you" 1 Peter 5 v 7

In the midst of a world full of anxiety we are given the assurance that we are not alone in our struggles. The world at the moment is a difficult place. There is the financial turmoil of the credit crunch, the uncertainty of a possible global flu pandemic and the threat of international terrorism. Many of us in the Fellowship may be experiencing difficulties with money worries, job stability, health problems or perhaps just the general stresses and strains of life. However, we have a God and Saviour who knows the end from the beginning, who created the earth and who ultimately controls all that happens in the world.
